- **Characteristics of successful GATE events**


- Opportunity could not get independently on own
- Customized for GATE kid's abilities
- Participative learning format - not just listening
- Interaction between GATE students
- Fun and interesting/exciting!

- **Logistics**

- Not sponsored by MVSD, MVSD staff do not participate
- Cash flow: pay for event up front, ticket income after event.
- Each parent is responsible for figuring out their child's transportation to/from the event. Parents seeking a ride will receive a list of other parents offering rides.
- Contract with event organization or free tours. Parents do not lead programs on their own - liability.
- Offer scholarships for paid events.

GATE Events - in future

- Parent point person to coordinate the event
 - Manage contact with event provider
 - Write up event description, cost - use event form
 - Get OK from GATE AC and finalize date
 - GATE AC sends email invitations for online registration
 - Greet participants at GATE event location
