

Job Title	Lead Coach, After-School Math Team (part time, Mill Valley)
Overall Responsibility	<p>You'll lead an after-school STEM* enrichment class, "<i>Math Olympiad Team</i>," onsite at one or more elementary schools in Mill Valley. You'll use proven curricula & world-class challenges to lead bright, motivated kids in grades 4-5 as they deepen their math skills through friendly competition. You'll be joining a growing nonprofit that is bringing advanced education opportunities to Marin children.</p> <p>* <i>STEM = Science, Technology, Engineering & Math</i></p>
Classroom Responsibilities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> You'll be head coach of each 60-minute weekly class session for 10-20 students in grades 4-5. You'll manage a small team of assistant coaches (typically a mix of parent volunteers and high school kids); you'll be responsible for your team showing up on time, prepared; you'll interact with school admin; you'll interact with the parents of your students. You'll use a prepared curriculum, to lead weekly 60-minute after-school meetings at one or more Mill Valley schools, expanding to teach the same class at more schools each week, with a target of four or more after-school and evening classes by later in the fall. The goal is to steadily increase teaching excellence and classes taught to leverage expertise and prep time across multiple schools. You'll run weekly practices; present topics in math, logic, and statistics; run five monthly competitions (Nov, Dec, Jan, Feb, Mar); score each team-mates work; reporting scores to Olympiad HQ; and present awards at end-of-year. One class takes about 2 hours/week of work, 50% in class, the rest in preparation, teaching team and parent communications.
Hours	Part-time: Initial commitment of 2 hrs/wk for seven-month term, Sep-Mar. Desirable to extend through Apr-May, too. After school, roughly 3:00-4:00. Chance to increase hours to 8 hrs/wk.
Qualifications	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Experience working with kids highly desirable. Experience as classroom teacher desirable but not required. Math knowledge and enthusiasm highly desirable. Math degree or experience in math career desirable but not required. Retired teachers/professors and STEM professionals encouraged to inquire; also parents of current MVSD students.
Skills & Competencies	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Teaching children; explaining concepts in math, logic, statistics; conveying enthusiasm and excitement; building team-work; celebrating achievements; patience with learners; maintaining order; management of small team; being organized and on-time. California standard school background check & TB test required.

Terms & Salary	1099 independent contractor. Compensation starts at \$60-240/week for 1-4 classes, with growth opportunities to teach more after school & evening classes, and even to recruit & train new Lead Instructors for <i>Math Olympiad Teams</i> in other communities. Compensation can increase with good progress and performance.
